9:00 – 11:00 20th Century Literature/Writing Class for grades 8-12.

Class cost is \$45/month and \$20 for each additional student from the same family.

Registration fee \$20 per student.

Teacher: Gwenda Peterson grew up in Fairhope, Alabama, and accepted Christ as her Savior in her early twenties. Mrs. Peterson earned a Bachelor of Arts in English with Secondary Education emphasis from Mississippi University for Women and a Master of Arts in English from Mississippi State University. She has taught English, history, and Bible to middle- and high-schoolers at Eastern Shore Christian Academy and Chi Alpha. Additionally, she has taught Freshman Composition at Mississippi State University and University of South Alabama, so she has first-hand experience with the writing needs of students entering college. Tapestry of Grace is a classical homeschool curriculum for the whole family. All grades will be learning geography, world history, and church history of the 20th century from a Biblical perspective.
